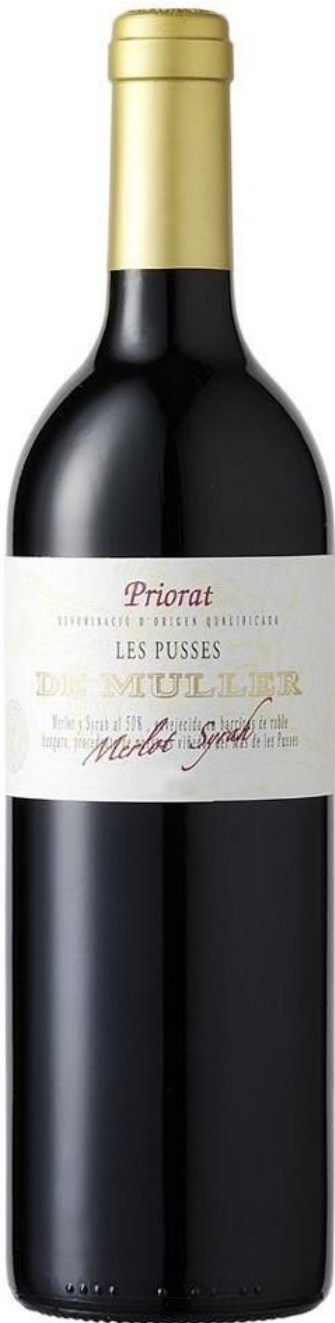




## **De Muller *Le Pusses* Priorat , 2013**

*Priorat, Catalunya*

In the south-eastern part of Priorat, there is a village known as El Molar, where the property “*Mas de les Pusses*” is nestled in the mountainous terraces of ancient volcanic soils. 34 hectares of vineyards total, this site has evidence of agriculture/viticulture going back further than the Roman era, and another 40 hectares in Tarragona. De Muller has the privilege of the oldest solera system in Catalunya as well as the first bottling line created in mainland Spain.



### **Vineyard**

*Les Pusses* in El Molar, Priorat

### **Soil**

Sandstone, Devonian Slate, Calciferous Scapolite

### **Varietals**

50% Merlot, 50% Syrah

### **Vinification**

Spontaneous malolactic in stainless steel.  
Aged in new Hungarian oak barrels for 12 mos.  
Bottle conditioned in cellar a minimum of 6 mos.

### **Tasting Notes**

“A perfect equilibrated and complex nose where we can feel slight floral notes of violets enhanced with a strong fruity aroma, a mixture of blackberries and blackcurrant together with spicy touches of vanilla and coconut provided by the Hungarian oak. It has a great personality in mouth, full-bodied and fantastically equilibrated. Fruity notes go together with spicy ones to finally arrive to dried fruits and rich chocolate flavors.”
