



## De Muller Solimar Tinto, 2016

*Tarragona, Catalunya*

In the south-eastern part of Priorat, there is a village known as El Molar, where the property “*Mas de les Pusses*” is nestled in the mountainous terraces of ancient volcanic soils. 34 hectares of vineyards total, this site has evidence of agriculture/viticulture going back further than the Roman era, and another 40 hectares in Tarragona. De Muller has the privilege of the oldest solera system in Catalunya as well as the first bottling line created in mainland Spain.



### Varietals

60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot

### Vinification

Spontaneous malolactic fermentation in stainless steel.  
Aged in American and French oak barrels for 12 – 14 mos.  
Bottle conditioned in cellar for a minimum of 6 mos.

### Tasting Notes

“A very nice cépage of the noble varieties Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot.  
A wonderful garnet color with carmine reflections.  
On the nose, it shows a complex aroma constituted by a primary variety aroma of green pepper, and a smoked and spicy aroma.  
In mouth it is warm, silky, with a mixture of tannin and acid sensations perfectly well structured. The slight smoked and spicy touches reflect perfectly the good condition of the wood in which it was grown...”
