San Vicente de la Sonsierra, La Rioja, Spain

From the heart of the Rioja Designation of Origin, inside the Rioja Alta, comes the collection Hacienda López de Haro. The Sonsierra, with the Sierra de Cantabria mountains on the north and the Ebro River on the south, is a perfect area for old-vines of Tempranillo. That is why this area has an ancient tradition of winegrowing and winemaking. Headed by winegrower and winemaker, Raúl Acha, utilizing hand-pruned mountain vineyards and natural methods.



Varietals

90% Viura, 10% Malvasia

From select old vines in the vineyards of Sonsierra de Toloño

Vinification

Fermentation starts with wild native yeasts, naturally, in open-top vats.

Aged in used French oak barrels for 3-4 mos. on lees.

Tasting Notes

“Ripe fruit, dates and banana notes stand out on the nose in combination with the nuances of the barrel. It is fresh and fleshy, leaving a long, balanced and pleasant aftertaste with clean minerality and an electric finish of round acidity.”
