Monastir brings back to life the authentic character of Navarra that marks a golden age of wine that took place in the beginning of the last century. From organically – grown properties harvested by the various cloisters of monks throughout centuries of winemaking, perfecting a quality in these wines that is singular and unique. All are unfinned and unfiltered, and extremely small production.



### **Varietals**

50% Tempranillo, 40% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot

### **Vineyards**

Mountainside: limestone & gravel with periodic clay

### **Vinification**

Wild, spontaneous fermentation and maceration in concrete.

16 mos. in new French oak barrels.

Unfinned and unfiltered.

### **2013 Production**

less than 300 cases

### **Tasting Notes**

“Rich notes of black fruit, cigar box and bramble spices on the palate.

The cabernet sauvignon grip is evident mid palate, exploding with cherry notes.

Pronounced, long tannins and an electric minerality on the finish.

Drink now through 2030.”
