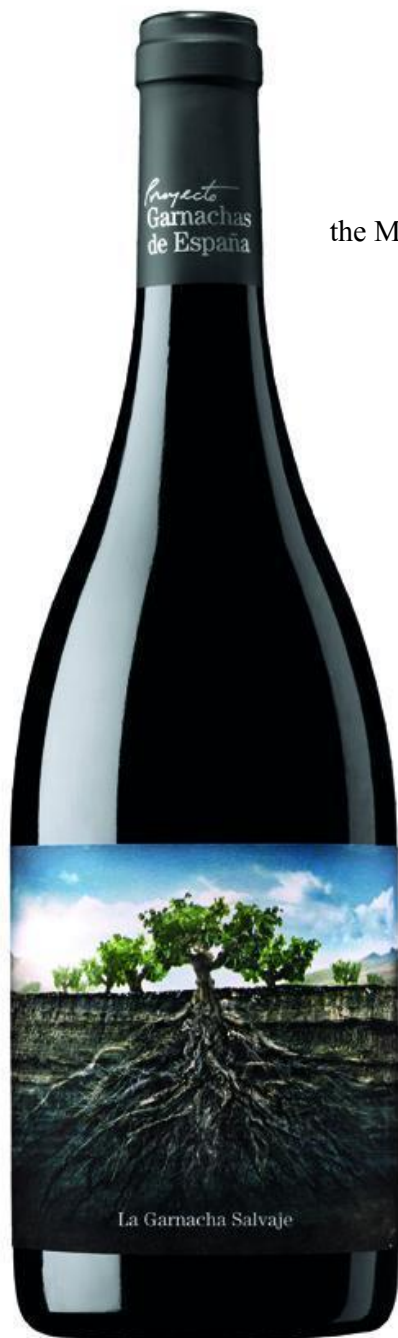




Proyecto Garnachas de España – La Garnacha Salvaje del Moncayo, 2017

Moncayo, Spain

Raúl Acha started his “Garnacha Project” with the goal to source exceptional vines of Garnacha from vineyards reflecting the multitude of unique expressions of this mother grape. He found himself discovering several vineyards yielding unique reflections of Garnacha, all from abandoned and forgotten sites where the vines grew wild, adjusting over decades of unattended growth to the rhythm of nature, with no human hands to influence them. This is the cornerstone of *Proyecto Garnacha*.



Varietals

100% Wild Garnacha

Vineyards located in a watershed area, on the north face of the Moncayo. Soils are rocky with a high percentage of slate and pebbles.

Vinification

5 mos. in used French oak barrels

Tasting Notes

“It is a bright burgundy wine with medium-depth. Tobacco and wild berry aromas. Bright pomegranate and cranberry notes on the palate.

It’s freshness and mineral qualities mix, resulting in a surprising wine that is a result of its roundness and youth.”
