Pyrenees Mountains, Uncastillo

Raúl Acha started his “Garnacha Project” with the goal to source exceptional vines of Garnacha from vineyards reflecting the multitude of unique expressions of this mother grape. He found himself discovering several vineyards yielding unique reflections of Garnacha, all from abandoned and forgotten sites where the vines grew wild, adjusting over decades of unattended growth to the rhythm of nature, with no human hands to influence them. This is the cornerstone of *Proyecto Garnacha*.



Varietals

100% Old Vine Garnacha of Biodynamic & Organic Vineyards.

Vineyards located between 800+ meters above sea level on southeastern mountainside slopes of the Pyrenees in Uncastillo (Zaragoza).

Vinification

12 mos. in French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

“Intense dark cherry color with deep garnet edges. Delicate and highly complex aromas of ripe black fruits and balsamic flavors. The body is balanced, fresh and rich with notes of raspberries, cranberries with subtle hints of pepper and orange peel. Herbaceous notes of rosemary and laurel accompanies the buttery smooth, long finish.”
