Winery Arts represents a selection of very low-yield biodynamic vineyards, situated on lands stretching from the high altitudes of the Moncayo mountain range in Aragon, up to the vibrant warmer lands crossed by the River Queiles, to the ancient northern kingdom of Navarre. The number nine – considered to be a powerful number representing humanity’s par excellence, an homage to the Benedictine monks whom harvested these vineyards since the 1300’s.



Varietals

70% Tempranillo, 30% Merlot

Vinification

Wild, spontaneous fermentation and maceration in concrete
for 3 weeks.

16 mos. in new French oak barrels, weekly battonage.

Unfined and unfiltered.

Tasting Notes

“Deep maroon robe, with a hint of spice on the nose. The palate is full of round red currants and forest berries, followed by a well – structured grip of black truffles and forest floor. The merlot adds body and nuance, reminiscent of Bordeaux’s right – bank characteristics.

Light black tea tannins and a touch of minerality on the finish.”
