From the heart of the Rioja Designation of Origin, inside the Rioja Alta, comes the collection Hacienda López de Haro. The Sonsierra, with the Sierra de Cantabria mountains on the north and the Ebro River on the south, is a perfect area for old-vines of Tempranillo. That is why this area has an ancient tradition of winegrowing and winemaking. Headed by winegrower and winemaker, Raúl Acha, utilizing hand-pruned mountain vineyards and natural methods.



Varietals

90% Tempranillo, 5% Garnacha, 5% Graciano

Vinification

Fermentation starts with wild native yeasts, naturally, in open-top concrete.
Aged in French and American oak barrels for 18 mos. and
cellared in bottle for conditioning for 1 yr.

Tasting Notes

“Aromas of ripe red fruit and liquorish combined with coffee, vanilla and balsamic nuances from the barrel aging.
The palate is smooth and velvety, with sweet and ripe tannins that make it a pleasant and easy-drinking wine with a long aftertaste.”
