



Hacienda López De Haro Gran Reserva, 2009

San Vicente de la Sonsierra, La Rioja, Spain

From the heart of the Rioja Designation of Origin, inside the Rioja Alta, comes the collection Hacienda López de Haro. The Sonsierra, with the Sierra de Cantabria mountains on the north and the Ebro River on the south, is a perfect area for old-vines of Tempranillo. That is why this area has an ancient tradition of winegrowing and winemaking. Headed by winegrower and winemaker, Raúl Acha, utilizing hand-pruned mountain vineyards and natural methods.

Varietals

90% Tempranillo, 10% Graciano

From select old vines on the Ebro River mountain terraces.

Vinification

Fermentation starts with wild native yeasts, naturally, in open-top concrete.

Aged in French oak barrels for 30 mos.

Hand racked quarterly, no vacuum pumps used in transfer.

Cellared in bottle for conditioning for more than 4 yrs.

Tasting Notes

“Nose is intense, mature, original and layered. The aroma of mature dark fruits develops into coffee, chocolate, vanilla and balsamic notes. The palate is persistent and elegant, intense and bold, but not hot and robust. Well balanced, full bodied wine with exceptionally long aftertaste.”
